



ITFM has been busy in Uganda. The clinic is functioning, with Winny, our clinical officer at the reins. Now the focus for ITFM will shift a bit towards the school. The first block of 2 classrooms is complete. Teachers are being hired and children are being enrolled in preschool, kindergarten and 1st grade. They are going to share the 2 classrooms until more are built. <u>School starts on January 28th.</u> At the end of 2013 we will need at least 2 more classrooms so these students can advance and more students can begin. ITFM also has to provide housing for the teachers by the end of this year.

Times are tough everywhere. The projects listed below are big ones but we are throwing them "out there".

Purchase teaching aids for one classroom	\$300
Depending on grade level, may include posters, rulers, scissors,	
maps, teaching guides, equipment, and/or curriculum.	
Buy school supplies for an entire classroom of students	\$500
Books, pencils, chalk, notebooks and a soccer ball for the whole class.	
Pay for teachers salaries for a month	\$1,000
Will cover 3-5 teachers depending on level of expertise.	
Provide desks for students and the teacher	\$2,000
Different sized benches are used for younger or older grades usually holding 2-3 students	
Dig and construct a pit latrine for the school	\$5,000
Bathroom stalls are built out of concrete over a deep pit.	
Need 1 for boys, 1 for girls, and one for teachers	
Build a classroom!	\$10,000
Built onsite in blocks of 2 with bricks, cement, metal roof, and metal doors.	
Holds up to 40 students and has a plaque in your honor on the wall.	
Build a teachers housing unit	\$15,000
Housing must be provided to retain quality teachers.	
Houses up to 6 teachers and their families.	
Build a block of classrooms!	\$20,000
2 classrooms sharing a metal roof, built with bricks, cement, and metal doors.	
Holds up to 80 students and each room has a plaque in your honor on the wall
