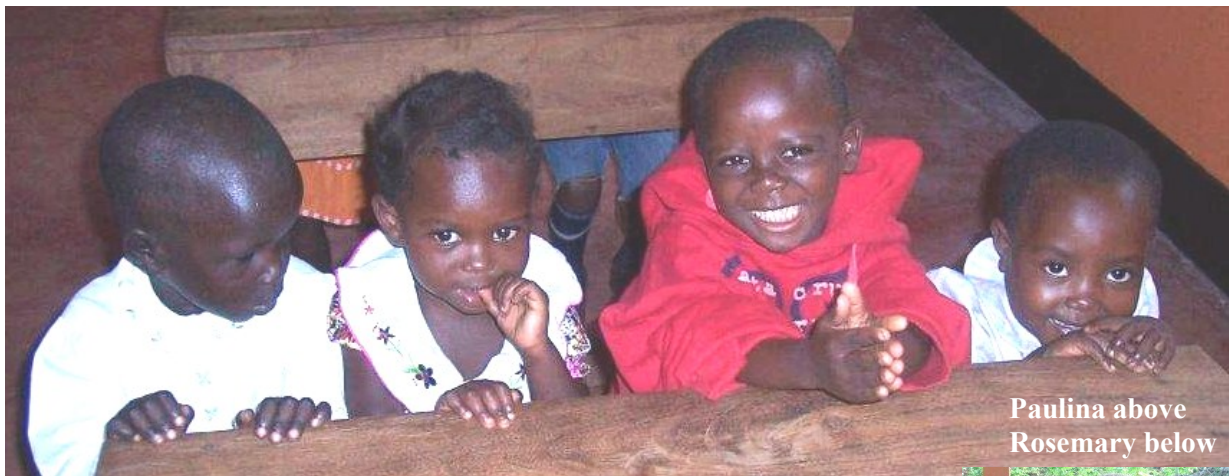

Urgent Funding Needs: A Teacher Housing Unit is an immediate need in Nabisooto. Only 1 qualified teacher is available within walking distance. Our other teacher is temporarily living in a small 1 room unit about the size of a walk-in closet on our property. ITFM needs to hire more teachers as the year progresses but there is no where for them to live. **\$15,000** is the cost of building a housing unit that can house 6 teachers and their families.

In addition to this need, a block of classrooms is the next top priority. Currently Integrity Primary School only has 2 classrooms. These students will progress to 1st and 2nd grade by the end of the year and in order for new preschool and kindergarteners to come in, we need 2 more classrooms. Each classroom costs **\$10,000** and are built in blocks of 2. Help these kids continue their education,

School is in session! The two brand new school rooms are open and the kids are so excited to be able to go to school and eat twice a day! Right now, thanks to you, ITFM is able to provide pre-school and 1st grade. Rosemary is so happy to be able to attend classes and learn with her younger sister, Paulina. Their mother suffers from an illness that causes her to pass out. Their elderly Grandmother lives with them to help out by caring for the new baby and working in the garden. Providing Rosemary and Paulina with an education is really going to help this family get out of the cycle of poverty.



Clinic News: Winny, our clinical officer, and Josephine have been working at the clinic since November and have been seeing patients regularly while in the process of finalizing our registration. As of January we are officially open. Villagers are coming with serious issues, the main one being Malaria. Imagine having 8 children and if one gets sick you must walk to the nearest clinic sometimes carrying your child. The villagers are so very happy that the ITFM clinic is open!

Note from Winny: The health facility has served over 250 patients so far from various villages, Initially patients had to travel over 10km to find health services. Some patients we are seeing: Richard- presented with severe peptic ulcer disease, Vicencia- treated for severe malaria, Leah- 1yr old toddler with Mild acute malnutrition and Malaria, she is being raised by a single mother who is a peasant and has other 4 children. Bukenya- 4 yr old child presented with acute viral infection and eye infections.
